



SUSTAINABLE PROCUREMENT POLICY

As the Senior Management of Jiva Beach Resort,

In our procurement activities, we aim to consider environmental and social impacts alongside quality, safety, economic and operational requirements, while supporting the local economy and sustainable use of resources.

Accordingly, we commit to:

- Ensuring that procured products and services comply with applicable legal, quality, food safety and operational requirements;
- Giving preference to **local and regional producers and suppliers** where quality, price, safety, continuity of supply and operational requirements are met, and monitoring local procurement performance;
- Evaluating, where appropriate, products that generate less packaging waste, are reusable or recyclable, or are manufactured from recycled materials;
- Considering **energy and water efficiency** in machinery and equipment selection where relevant to the intended use;
- Giving preference, where practicable, to durable, long-lasting products with lower environmental impacts and products sourced from sustainable resources;
- Considering valid **environmental, quality, food safety or sustainability certifications** relevant to the nature of the product or service among supplier selection criteria;
- Supporting cooperation with suppliers that operate in accordance with legal, ethical and responsible business principles;
- Refraining from supporting the procurement of products obtained illegally or derived from protected species or species whose hunting or trade is prohibited by law;
- Evaluating suppliers against relevant procurement and sustainability criteria and **continually improving our procurement practices.**
